

## Special Notes on Quizzing

1. Passages for quizzes are on the entry form as well as on the What's Our Plan page. Please look carefully at this year's list of quizzing passages, both on the entry form, and the What's Our Plan page.

2. Please enter children (even big ones!) **only** in quizzes you have personally prepared them for (or supervised their preparation). If entrants are good jumpers, but are not properly prepared, they can preclude those who have worked hard, and the quiz turns into a joke or a guessing game.

While confidence helps the child jump, it is preparation that helps them **internalize** the foundational truths. Quizzing needs to be more than a contest for a day. The reason for quizzing is to help make it more attractive to learn the Biblical facts, which is increasingly difficult in this electronics driven age.

3. The reason parents need to be personally involved is that they need to know the information themselves. This is not just for Celebration Day, but for weaving information and principles into daily life. If parents make up their own quiz questions for use at home, they just naturally master the material themselves and so can build on those understandings and apply them to real life.

Use questions you have made on various passages in the car, around the table, while doing chores with a child, at bed time, etc. as well as at more formal times. (Deuteronomy 6)
